From April 2022, the legal age of majority is 18 years old.

From April 2022, all 18 years old and over will be considered as adults. When you are an adult, you can enter into a contract by yourself. However, you will lose your right to revoke a contract made without your parent's consent. Therefore, it will be difficult for you to get out of a contract. However, you can not smoke nor drink until you are 20 years old.

People who just became adults are vulnerable to be cheated when they enter into contracts. When you are in trouble, call 188 and ask for advice. If you do not speak Japanese, call the Shizuoka Assistance Center for Foreign Residents, Camellia at 054-204-2000.
