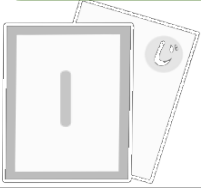


This learning record is used to document your personal evaluation of your Japanese language ability, things you need to learn through activities, and things you have learned in order to proactively acquire Japanese language skills.
