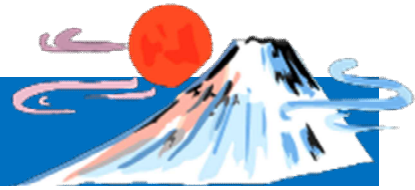


4. Fujinomiya Higashi High School

Mt.Fuji Studies



Here at Shizuoka Prefectural Fujinomiya Higashi High School, second-year students in the general education department take part in a 'Mt. Fuji Studies' class during which they aim to spread the charm and culture of the region to the world.

The students focused on and explored Mount Fuji's natural science characteristics, its value as a World Cultural Heritage site, and its significance from a disaster prevention perspective. They then created a presentation based on these various aspects.

They deepened their understanding by listening to lectures by experts, touring the Mt. Fuji World Heritage Center, touring the properties that make up the World Cultural Heritage Site including Miho no Matsubara, the Museum of Natural and Environmental History, Shizuoka, and the Tokaido Hiroshige Museum of Art.
